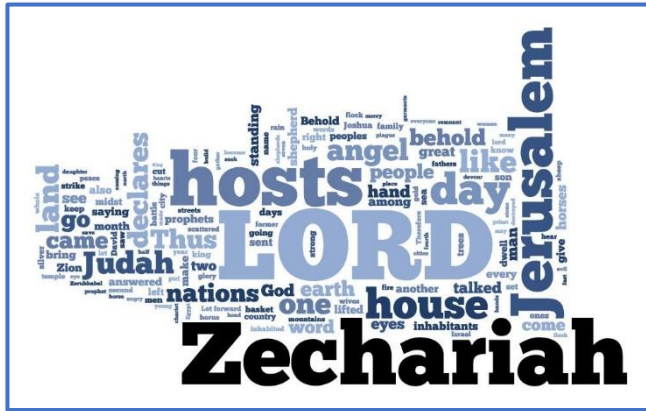


## WORD Cloud of the week

### Keeping you and your loved ones safe at Church.

At Christ Church we take our safeguarding responsibilities very seriously. Our Safeguarding Team consists of Rev Chris Kent – Associate Priest, Rachel Prosser – Safeguarding Administrator, Liz Shaw and Carol Smith – Parish Safeguarding Officers. We work closely with the Diocesan Safeguarding Officers who are always on hand to offer help and support. We ensure that everyone who works with children, young people and vulnerable adults are DBS (*Disclosure and Barring Service*) checked and have the appropriate safeguarding training for their role.

**Incidents** We look into every incident reported to us – no matter how small or trivial it may seem. This is recorded and reported to the Diocesan officers who advise us of any steps to take.

To continue to keep everyone safe we need your help . . . Safeguarding is the responsibility of all of us, so if you have concerns about someone or have seen something that is disturbing, please contact either Liz or Carol, or any member of the team listed above if we aren't available.
