FRIDAY STREET TO CHAPEL LANE . . . an Easter parable.

Running alongside my childhood home is a footpath with rustic stiles at each end. Opposite Friday Street – as if to shout “*Good Friday*” – this giant limestone slab is big enough to cover a small cave entrance, reminiscent of the stone across the front of Jesus’ tomb. What a great reminder of that faced by the women wondering how it could be moved out of their way on that first Easter morning!



One hundred yards further on, as if to represent the empty crosses on Calvary’s hill, were three wooden posts above the end steps onto Chapel Lane – another appropriate name!



Hoping one day I could use this image I have at last, half a century on, this opportunity to show it here! The wooden posts have now gone, but not the stone stile opposite Friday Street (photographed by my brother just this week).

Our world may have lost sight of the ‘old rugged cross’ but the stone that revealed that empty tomb still testifies to the victorious resurrection of this world’s own Saviour.
