"Hear Ye! Hear Ye!"

'Being heard' is a recurring theme in Scripture, mainly deafness to God's voice and His teaching, not due to any physical failing but instead, simply listening to someone or something else:

"... you pay no attention; your ears are open, but you do not listen." (Isaiah 49:20)

Paul, in his final instruction, also quotes from Isaiah (6:9,10):

"Go to this people and say, 'You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving.' For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them." (Acts 28:26,27)

Hearing with the heart

'Listening' is a selective process; do we listen to the enemy? The god of this age "has blinded the minds of unbelievers" (2Corinthians 4:4) whereas Jesus "opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures." (Luke 24:45)

Who are we listening to, and who are we speaking God's word to?
